



Extension Services

The SKSU is mandated to discharge extension functions to support its primordial mission of offering professional and technical training in science and technology, literature, philosophy, and arts and science.

Extension, therefore, becomes an essential function of the University. It is vital in the attainment of the University's goals and objectives. Extension, to be functional, shall be guided by its mission to seek an increasing prominent role in strengthening and sustaining promotion and dissemination of technologies, knowledge, skills and attitudes aimed at supporting and enhancing development efforts of the University as well as that of the province and the region.

The Extension division is headed by the Vice President for RD & E with the Director, the Campus Extension Coordinators and the Administrative Support Staff.

A. Extension Program

This Year the Extension Division has a lot of Projects that helps promote development to the life of Filipinos to be self-reliant and better citizen who will eventually help build a strong and progressive Nation. The following were the projects undertaken by the University.

- Fostering Migrant B'laan Community in Tacurong City
- Impact Assessment of Extension Programs of Sultan Kudarat State University
- Capability Building of Organic Farmers in Bagumbayan, Sultan Kudarat
- Capability Building Advocacy on Organic Agriculture among Urban and Sub-urban
- Communities in Sultan Kudarat
- Capacitating Fisherfolks in Ecosystem Approach to Management
- Local Industry, Finance and Enterprise thru Training Opportunities on Livelihood Services (LIFE thru TOOLS)
- Women's Empowerment through Literacy Program in Barangay New Passi, Tacurong City
- Alternative Learning System for Out-of-School Youths and Adults

B. Project Implementers

SKSU is also a recipient of the different projects like:

1. Farmer Livestock School-Goat Enterprise Management (FLS-GEM)

SKSU in collaboration of PCAARD facilitated a program that produced trained facilitators, who will conduct the Farmer Livestock School on Goat Enterprise Management (FLS-GEM) in their respective local government units.

SKSU as recipient of this program was able to organize pool of experts and has already started livestock schools in Region XII (SOCCSKSARGEN) particularly in North Cotabato, Saranggani, Sultan Kudarat, Koronadal City and General Santos City. In 20 14 to the present, there were already 334 graduates of the program.

2. "Nutriskwela", Radyo Mo sa Nutrition, and One Nutrition One Nation Program

This is the advocacy strategy of the Department of Health-National Nutrition Council (DOH-NNC) to promote health and nutrition to as many people and households as possible. This national program has established 35 community radio stations all over the country and SKSU was one of the recipients with the radio station operating in the Main Campus. Various sectors are given priority in the programming especially religious, youth, senior citizen, Alternative Learning System (DepEd), AFP and Police Information and other line agencies advocacies.

3. Reading Camp (Basic Education Enhancement)

This is a project with Save the Children Philippines, a world-wide organization advocating protection of the rights of children including provision of support to basic and essential opportunities to all children more specifically in areas that are not accessible to services such as health, education etc. The University is providing manpower and expertise to include the students that are volunteers to manage and implement the "literacy boost" to grades 1 to 3 pupils in reading

camps established in target areas in Sultan Kudarat.

4. Mindanao Sustainable Agrarian Reform and Agriculture Development (MinSAAD)

This year Sultan Kudarat (DARPO – SK) as a Service Provider to conduct the training for their Agrarian Reform Beneficiary Organizations (ARBOs) in Baluan and Kalibuhan, Palimbang, Sultan Kudarat through the Mindanao Sustainable Agrarian Reform and Agriculture Development (MinSAAD) Project under Agribusiness and Agro-Forestry Development (AAD) funded by Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

The project aims to address poverty issues through competitive and sustainable agriculture using an integrated, area – based and inclusive approach and modalities in investments that are based on value chain analysis of key agriculture commodities.

A total of 49 farmers and senior high school – agriculture stand had successfully completed the farmer’s field school on corn production with emphasis on corn breeding.

5. Southeast Asia Regional Initiative for Community Empowerment (SEARICE)

Sultan Kudarat State University (SKSU) is now a partner institution of Southeast Asia Regional Initiative for Community Empowerment (SEARICE) through inception meeting started on May 2018 on the Rights to Seeds (RISE) Program funded by Fastenopfer a Swiss Catholic Lenter Fund which will be piloted at Bagumbayan, Lutayan and Tacurong for the implementation of breeding on corn, rice and vegetables.

6. Department of Agrarian Reform – Italian Agrarian Reform Community Development Support Program (DAR-IARCDSP) Of Sultan Kudarat and Sarangani Province. The Department of Agrarian Reform in the Province of Sultan Kudarat and Sarangani is intensifying the capability enhancement of its agrarian reform beneficiaries with the assistance program funded by the Italian Government. Whereas, the SKSU engaged as Professional Service Provider to conduct identified capability and technical trainings.

C. Expert Services

SKSU as service provider to various programs with other line agencies and topped as consultants, trainers, facilitators and evaluators. Trainings and workshops were conducted to farmers and other beneficiaries to disseminate technologies, evaluate capabilities, and assist the beneficiaries in terms of technical advisory and capability building on financial literacy, proposal making, strategic planning, organizational assessment, good governance, climate change adaptation and resilience, environmental awareness and protection, gender and development, etc.

Some of these projects that had created significant impact to communities were:

1. Regulatory Simplification Program. This is a Program of National Competitiveness Council (NCC) with Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), and Local Government Academy (LGA) to assist the LGUs in upgrading the Business Processing and Licensing System (BPLS) streamlining. Consultants Training was conducted for selected private and SUCs representatives in the country and SKSU is now extending services to LGUs in Region XII through the trained consultant.

2. Farmers’ Satisfaction Survey. Team of researchers from SKSU conducted the Farmers’ Satisfaction Survey as third party validator for National Irrigation Association (NIA) to get the truthful feed-back from the IAs officers and members regarding the quality, efficiency and effectiveness of their service delivery.

3. Business Permitting and Licensing System Validation. The Department of Trade and Industry-National Competitiveness Council-Local Government Academy with SKSU research team as third party validator of the Business Permitting and Licensing System Streamlining of selected LGUs in Region XII. The validation is part of establishing competitiveness index of selected areas in terms of ease of doing business. Data and information will be also used in determining compliance to standards set for processing business permits.

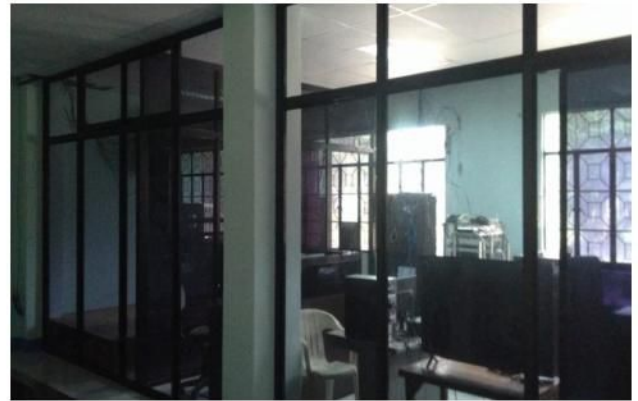

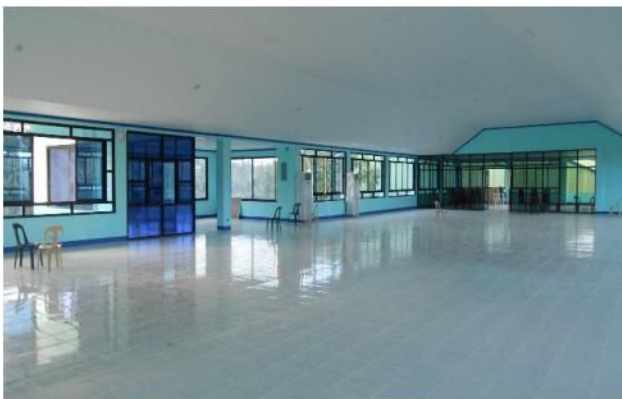

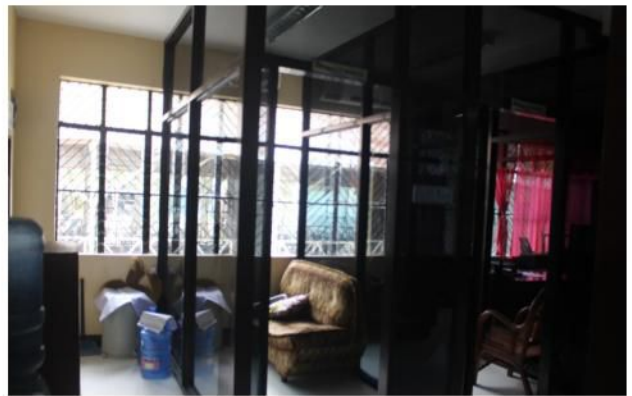
